



The Palette



When you launch LiveMath you will have a notebook. Like the one holding this comment.

You will also have a separate window called the palette.

It looks like this:




If you do not see a palette you can bring it up. In the Menu Bar, go to the Notebook Menu then Palettes, then select the Full Palette or Small Palette.

You can get rid of the Palette by clicking on its close box.



The buttons with similar types of function are collected together on the palette. The areas have titles: Graph, Build, Symbols, Compute, Select, and Edit. In addition to the buttons you see in these areas there are hidden buttons. Some of the palette buttons bring up mini-palettes.

Click and hold the mouse button down on .

 A pop-up mini-palette will appear



These are several available relational options.



Buttons that have pop-up sub-palettes have a small triangle in the lower left hand corner.
